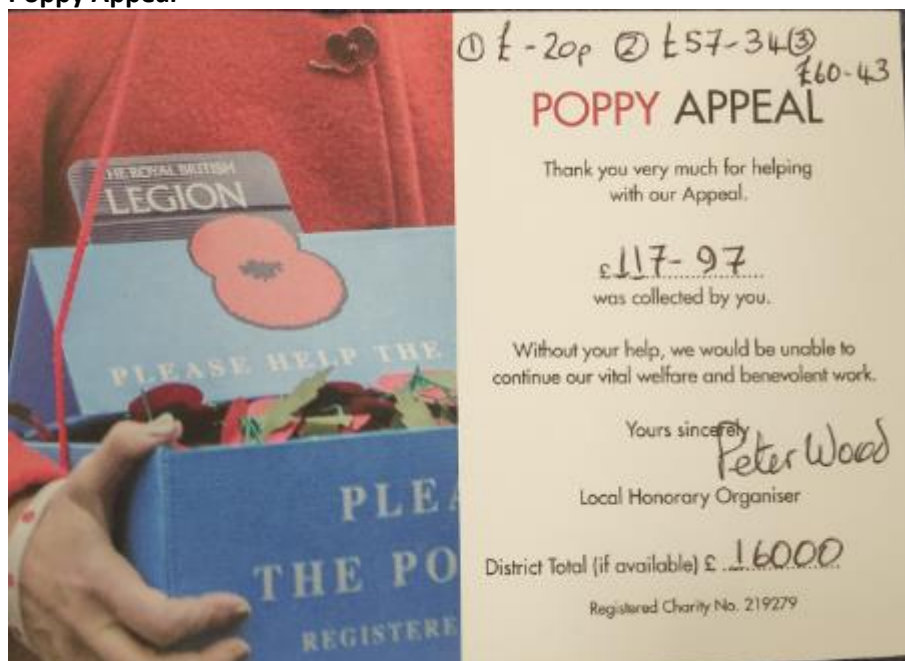
PE kit reminder

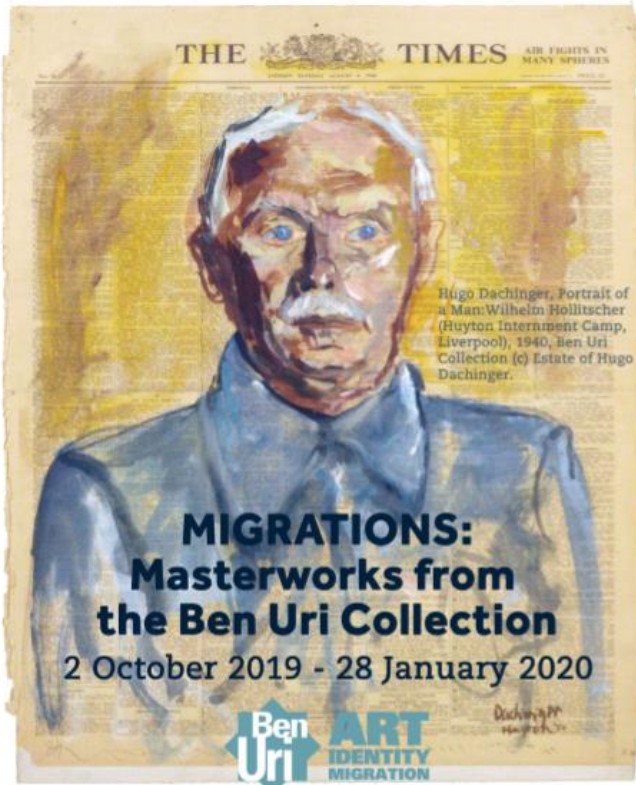
